



## 2026-2027 DRESS CODE

### The King's Academy Student Dress Code

The following expectations apply every school day, unless otherwise stated. All items must meet these standards without exception. Anything not addressed below is not permitted.

#### Daily Apparel Requirements

##### Tops

- Students must wear a TKA polo or oxford.
- The polo must have the official TKA logo on the top left corner.
- Approved polo colors: black, purple, gray, or white.
- No other shirts are permitted.

##### Bottoms

- Students may only wear approved Lands End or Global School Wear khaki, black, or gray uniform pants shorts, skirts, skorts, or jumpers.
- No other colors or materials (such as spandex or other synthetics) are allowed.
- Only approved Lands End or Global School Wear skirts and skorts in TKA plaid, khaki, black, or gray.
- Shorts, skirts, and skorts should be no shorter than 3" above the knee as measured in the front and back.
- Black bike shorts or leggings are REQUIRED to be worn under skirts. Black leggings should be at or near the ankle. Black bike shorts must be worn under skirts at all times.



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### Outerwear

- All outerwear must display the official TKA logo.
- Approved outerwear colors: black, purple, gray, or white.
- Any jacket, hoodie, sweatshirt, or pullover without a TKA logo is not permitted.

### Shoes

- Shoes must be closed-toed and closed-heeled.
- Shoes must be either athletic shoes, casual dress shoes, or boots.
- All other footwear is not allowed.

### Spirit Wear Friday

Spirit Wear Friday is the only exception to the daily dress code, with the exceptions as follows.

Students may wear:

- Blue denim jeans (no rips, frays, tears, or holes)
- Athletic pants/shorts (no sweatpants, leggings, jeggings, or spandex material)
- Shorts, skirts, and skorts should be no shorter than 3" above the knee as measured in the front and back.
- TKA T-shirt

All other dress code rules remain in place on Spirit Wear Friday.

### Compliance

Students must arrive at school fully in dress code and remain in dress code for the entire school day.



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### SPECIAL EVENT (FORMAL) DRESS:

- Girls - Dresses, or skirts and blouses, or formal suits that meet the following guidelines are acceptable. Length should be no shorter than 3" above the knee as measured in the front and back. The midriff should always remain covered. Backs should not be cut below the bottom of the shoulder blades. Necklines should be modest (no more than three inches below the collarbone). Outfits should be of opaque fabric and not inappropriately tight. Dress shoes are to be worn. Open-toe, open-heel styles are acceptable; flip-flops, athletic or other casual shoes are not acceptable.
- Boys - Dress pants, dress shirts, dress shoes, dress socks, dress belts and ties are to be worn. Flip-flops, athletic or other casual shoes are not acceptable.

### PROM & HOMECOMING COURT:

- Girls - Prom and homecoming dresses must be viewed on the individual in advance for suitable fitting - no exceptions. Skirts of the dresses may not be sheer (see through) material. Length should be no shorter than 3" above the knee as measured in the front and back. Neckline and backline must be modest (backline must be above the natural waistline). Spaghetti straps and strapless styles are acceptable, if modest. The midriff should always remain covered. No open sides or sheer panels. No immodest tight dresses are allowed. Viewing dates will be provided for both homecoming and prom.
- Boys - Suit & Tie or Tuxedo, Dress Shoes (For Homecoming Court, football players may remain in uniform.)
